Church Life

There's a lot going on at Maryland Heights to help you develop as a disciple. We don't have room to list everything, but these are the kind of activities that you'll see regularly at our church.



Worship - Sunday mornings together is a highlight for us at Maryland Heights. We look forward to praising God together and drawing close to him and to others disciples.

Bible Study—Sundays at 9:30 am and Wednesdays at 7:00 pm we meet for small group Bible studies. These less formal gatherings are great opportunities to explore Scripture together and discuss practical ways to apply it.





Family Activities—Almost every month we host a big event for families and friends. From game nights to church-wide dinners, we look forward to spending time with one another and meeting new friends who come as guests.

Life Groups—These friendship groups meet monthly and are always open for new members and guests. They meet in people's homes, at the building or at a local restaurant. They're great places to get to know people better.

Outward Looking Ministries

Jesus calls us to look beyond the walls of our church and see the needs around us. We are committed to extending our reach in our neighborhood and across the globe. Here are a few ways our members do that.



Missions and Outreach The message of Jesus offers such hope that we are eager to share it across the street and around the globe. We contribute funds and volunteer to bring God's good news to as many as possible.



Room At The Inn One night each month we turn our building into an inn for homeless in our community. Our volunteers provide these families with a comfortable bed, hot meals and caring support and encouragement.



"We Care" Bears On the first Tuesday of the month volunteers gather to sew and stuff handcrafted teddy bears for children in local hospitals. These, along with others items like pillows and wheelchair caddies, are given to young and old in hospitals and nursing homes.



Community Helping Ministries We volunteer in this cooperative community ministry to help the most needy in our community with food and some financial assistance. Throughout the year we help raise funds, donate canned goods and volunteer our time serving to make lives better.



Camp Ne-O-Tez Many of our members volunteer each year to staff, refurbish and run this camp that trains K-12 graders to walk with Christ. It's in this beautiful setting near Desoto, Missouri. You can find out more about it at www.neotez.org

Bible Classes Classes for kids of all ages meet on Sundays at 9:30 am and Wednesdays at 7:00 pm. There they learn about God and his plan for their lives through the great stories of the Bible.



Teen Program Our 6-12 graders that meets for Bible study on Sundays and Wednesdays as well as other events to build friendships, help them grow closer to God and learn to serve others.





GEMS Once a month during the school year, our 1-5 grader girls meet after worship for an afternoon of hands-on mentoring and fun.



Kid's Worship* K-5th graders meet for worship on their level with singing, story time and puppets. It's at the bottom of the main stairwell.




Busy Bee* 2–5 year old children meet during worship for a worship experience designed just for them. They meet just off our lobby.


